Recreational Group Skating Program INFORMATION

Deadline for Winter Programs: by December 12, 2015.

Register early SPACE IS LIMITED. Will accept registrations until classes are full.

Skate Kingston offers Skate Canada sanctioned recreational group skating lessons with NCCP Certified Professional Coaches. These two pages provide information about our programs to help you complete the REGISTRATION FORM. Visit our website for updates, special events and news.

IMPORTANT – Parents MUST remain in the arena during their child's lesson.

PROGRAMS- Winter 2016

- GROUP LESSONS START: Saturday Jan. 2, Monday Jan. 4, Wednesday Jan 6, Thursday Jan. 7
- MANDATORY SKATE CANADA FEE: \$33, included in all recreational program costs

CanSkate INVISTA Centre: *Mon 6:20-7:05 pm; Wed 6:15-7:00 pm; Thurs 6:00-6:45 pm; Sat 10:20 -11:05 am* For skaters age 3 ½ and up who are **willing and able** to go on the ice unassisted by a parent. This 45 minute program allows skaters to master basic skating skills that include skating forwards, backwards, jumping, spinning, turning and stopping. Skaters receive ongoing incentives and a report card in March.

Cost: \$180 for 10 sessions

Parent & Tot INVISTA Centre: Mon 6:20-7:05 pm; Wed 6:15-7:00 pm; Thurs 6:00-6:45 pm; Sat 10:20 -11:05 am A 45 minute introductory program allows the young skater (age 3 and up), to learn to skate with the assistance of one of their parents on the ice with them. The parent needs to be able to skate on their own to participate in this program. Skaters receive ongoing incentives and a report card in March. The Parent & Tot are on the ice at the same time as the CanSkate session. Fees include mandatory Skate Canada fee of \$33 for the same parent each week and child. Note: If you enrol in the Parent & Tot for 20 weeks and the skater is ready to move to CanSkate prior to the end of 20 weeks, the only fee the parent has paid is the Skate Canada registration fee.

Cost: \$215 for 10 sessions: 1 skater + 1 parent

For a different parent or quardian to skate an additional Skate Canada fee is required.

Adult Learn-to-Skate INVISTA Centre: Thursday 8:00-8:50 pm

It is never too late to learn to skate! Adults (and teenagers) of all ages can enjoy a 50 minute program learning to skate in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere. Program includes a 30 minute group lesson. Skaters receive ongoing incentives and a report card in March.

Cost: \$215 for 10 sessions

SKATE CANADA HELMET POLICY CSA hockey helmets are mandatory for every adult and child participating. Please see Skate Kingston website for more information.

REGISTRATION FORMS and cheques will be accepted until classes are full. Skate Kingston will be holding registration during the CanSkate sessions on Dec. 2, 3, 5 & 7. Forms may also be mailed OR dropped off in the Skate Kingston mailbox at the INVISTA centre. **Make your cheque or money order payable to: Skate Kingston**.

FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT

Fundraising is a very important part of any non-profit organization. At Skate Kingston this will help to keep ice and program costs reasonable for everyone and contributes to events that are held throughout the year. This money will be used for the following Skate Kingston events: Theme Days, Ice Show, and Annual General Meeting & Awards Banquet.

There is a mandatory \$30.00 fundraising fee payable once/year for each family enrolled in any of the Skate Kingston's recreational programs. If a family member was enrolled in a fall session, you do not pay this fee again. This mandatory fundraising fee paid with registration may be recouped by selling the bag of 15 Lamontagne Chocolates for \$2 each. These chocolates will be distributed sometime during the first weeks of skating.

Families with skaters in both CanSkate & STARSkate programs are ONLY required to do the STARSkate fundraising and volunteer commitments (see STARSkate package). Fundraising fee is NOT charged to families that have PRO KIDS assistance, but volunteer commitment applies (see STARSkate package). Skaters moving to STARSkate from CanSkate during the fall or winter season will be required to fulfill all or partial STARSkate volunteer and fundraising commitments depending on length of season remaining. Fees would be determined and pro-rated.


