COVID REMINDERS

- Skaters should have a bag of some sort to put their mask at the boards when skating. No masks should be left on their own at the boards. Skaters may also stash them in their pockets if they choose.
- Skaters need to remember to stay 6 feet away from their friends when on the ice and in the change room.
- Reminder to parents that only one parent can enter the rink with their son or daughter. Siblings are not permitted into the facility.
- Parents are reminded they can ONLY watch from the bleachers inside the facility, and not from the side of the boards or from inside the lobby. We want you to continue watching your child skate but if this rule is continuously broken, parents may not be permitted to watch at all.
- Please note, the City has emailed indicating if a parent wants to watch any portion of the skater's session, they must come in with the skater. You cannot drop the skater off and then come in part way through the session. You will not be permitted entry after the session has started. However, if a skater is late for the session, both skater and parent will be allowed into the arena, pending they are together.
