Payment via credit card is preferred, but you can also choose cash or cheque which can be mailed or dropped off at the Skate Kingston mailbox by the INVISTA Centre front desk. New members to our club, can create an account at any time to save time once registration opens. Be sure that you list the parent who is financially responsible for the account, as the MEMBER, and skaters as the PARTICIPANTS.

Skate Kingston Refund Policy:

Requests must be made in writing before February 26th, 2021. Requests for refund after this date are at the discretion of the board and a medical note is mandatory. A \$45 non-refundable insurance and administrative fee will apply. **NSF cheque charge \$30.00.**

PLEASE NOTE: Schedules and information are subject to change. Skate Kingston is not responsible for loss of ice due to events beyond our control, including inclement weather. No refunds will be given for loss of ice out of Skate Kingston's control and any makeup ice is at the discretion of the City of Kingston.

NOTE: Because Skate Kingston is only able to confirm ice schedules on a month-to-month basis as a result of the current pandemic, schedule changes may occur after February. By registering for this program, you are agreeing to accept the risk of possible minor changes to ice times for the duration of the program. Please note that any major changes to ice times and/or cancellations as a result of monthly ice calendar changes, will be reviewed outside of existing refund policies.

Liability Waiver and Release:

It is understood and agreed that Skate Kingston shall NOT be responsible or held liable for any damages, injury, or loss of property to any member, guest or visitor to Skate Kingston regardless of the reason or nature of such damage, loss or injury. Every member, guest or visitor who participates in Skate Kingston on-ice or off-ice activities shall use the Club facilities at his or her own risk. The signatory shall indemnify Skate Kingston and hold them harmless from any claims. The undersigned acknowledges having received and read and agrees to abide by all rules of Skate Kingston and all Skate Canada rules in effect from time to time. **Liability Waiver and Release must be read and signed during the online registration.** Please direct any concerns or questions to the Director.

PROGRAMS – February to March 2021

Pre-STAR INVISTA Centre, CUPE 109 Ice Pad:

• Saturday February 20th – March 20th; 7:45 am – 8:35 am

The Pre-Star Program (Pre-Star) is a program that serves as a transition between CanSkate and STARSkate. This program is geared to skaters who show an interest in figure skating and have a basic skating background. Skaters are typically on CanSkate Stage 5 or 6 badge. Please note that skaters <u>must wear figure</u> <u>skates</u>. This program is on at the same time and ice as the Adult & Teen Learn-to-Skate session.

Skaters registered in Fall 2020: \$108.00
 Skaters not registered in Fall 2020: \$152 (Mandatory Skate Canada & Safe Sport Fee of \$44 is included in this program cost)

IMPORTANT – One parent/guardian MUST remain in the arena <u>during</u> their child's lesson. Only one parent/guardian is allowed as a spectator for each CanSkate/Pre-STAR participant. Spectators must sit in the upper stands throughout the session.

Adult & Teen Learn-to-Skate INVISTA Centre, CUPE 109 Ice Pad:

• Saturday February 20th – March 20th; 7:45 am – 8:35 am

Adults and teenagers of all ages can enjoy a 50-minute program learning to skate in a relaxed and friendly group lesson atmosphere. Session includes a 50-minute group lesson with a certified coach. Skaters receive ongoing incentives and a report card in December. This program is on at the same time and ice as the Pre-STAR session.

- Skaters registered in Fall 2020: \$108.00
 Skaters not registered in Fall 2020: \$152 (Mandatory Skate Canada & Safe Sport Fee of \$44 is included in this program cost)
- Some basic skating is required for the Winter 2021 program. Adult/Teen skaters **MUST** be able to stand up on ice with no assistance. Due to current COVID-19 protocols, coaches are unable to touch skaters.
- Minimum age for this session is 12 years of age.
- Please note that this program may not run if minimum registration numbers are not reached.

Spectators are <u>NOT</u> allowed for the Adult Learn-to-Skate program.
