Spring 2025 STARSkate Skating Programs INFORMATION

April 1 – May 29, 2025

Operated at INVISTA Centre, CUPE 109 Ice pad

This information relates to Skate Kingston Spring 2025 STARSkate Program information ONLY.

Registration begins as follows:

- Skate Kingston Home Club skater registration begins Thursday March 6th at 9:00 pm
- Non-Home Club skater registration begins Sunday March 9th at 8:00 pm

Please note: There is no switching of home clubs for Spring or Summer session. Any non-home club skaters who register before Sunday March 9th at 8:00 pm will have their registration cancelled.

As a reminder, Adult STARSkaters wishing to skate on youth ice are required to be registered for the Adult STAR session. Requests for youth ice will need to be submitted to the SK President, Kat Popielaty, for review by the board when all youth registration is complete. Approval may be granted if there is room on youth ice.

Deadline for Spring 2025 registration is Friday March 28th @ 9 pm

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE FIRST WEEK OF SPRING SKATING:

April 1st

• SK is offering a drop-in STAR A session. In order to participate, you must register separately for this session.

April 2nd:

- SK is offering a "couples dance" trial drop-in skate. This 45 minute session is meant for those skaters who may be interested in competing in couples dance for the 2025/26 skating season.
- For more information, please speak to a coach. In order to participate, you must register separately for this session.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Registration will be online at https://Skatekingston.uplifterinc.com. Payment via credit card is preferred, but you can also choose cash or cheque which can be mailed or dropped off at the Skate Kingston mailbox by the INVISTA Centre front desk. For anyone that has not used our online registration system, please see the following link on the Skate Kingston website: http://skatekingston.com/registration/. New members to our club, can create an account at any time to save time once registration opens. Be sure that you list the parent who is financially responsible for the account, as the MEMBER, and skaters as the PARTICIPANTS.
- Similar to previous sessions, qualifications will be based on a point system (outlined in Appendix A).
- STARSkate sessions are reserved for youth under 20 years of age. Exceptions to age limitations must be approved by the Skate Kingston Board of Directors.

Skate Kingston Refund Policy:

Requests for refund must be made in writing <u>prior to the end of the second week of skating</u>. Requests for refund after this time will be at the discretion of the board. A \$15 non-refundable insurance and administrative fee will apply. **NSF cheque charge \$30.**

Guest Skating/Dance Partnering:

Guest skating will be available as "Drop-In" through Uplifter if there is room available on the session. Dance partnering is currently allowed, and a dance partnering 20 min guest fee is available at the discretion of the board. As a reminder, please note there is no guest skating the week before the May 2025 High Assessment day.

Credits will be uploaded shortly. If you are expecting credits, and would like to use them towards Spring registration, please select "Pay in Person" when completing your registration, so that your invoice can be updated once credits are uploaded. NOTE: Youth STARSkate session ice for Adult skaters wanting to do more than one session will be limited this Spring based on numbers. *To qualify for STARSkate session ice, Adult STARSkaters MUST be registered for Adult STARSkate.*

This program will not run if registration minimums are not met.

Off-Ice for STAR B and C skaters:

Off-ice opportunities are available (see monthly calendar) and it is encouraged that all skaters participate in off-ice if they are able. To encourage participation, all STAR B and C off-ice for the Spring 2025 session has been included in overall programming costs.

Off-ice begins April 7th, 2025.

APPENDIX A: Skate Kingston Skating Level Matrix

Skate Kingston's qualifications for STAR A, B & C are based on STAR points outlined below.

Skaters can have different levels (points) for the different disciplines of FreeSkate, Skills and Dance – but must have certain overall total points for qualification for the sessions. In addition to the total points to be on a session, skaters must have completed certain tests to qualify.

Example 1: Jenny has completed her full STAR 2 Freeskate; STAR 4 Skills; and all STAR 3 dances. See green highlight for points total. Jenny has a total score of 2+4+3 = 9. Based on the chart above, Jenny qualifies for B session.


Example 2: John has completed his full STAR 1 Freeskate; STAR 1 Skills; and STAR 1 dances. He is working on his STAR 2 dances but has not passed all of them. See purple highlight for points total. John has a total score of 1+1+1=3. While John has all the level requirements for STAR B, he does NOT have the STAR points need to be eligible for STAR B. He is therefore eligible for STAR A.



Skate Kingston aims to promote a safe, supportive environment for the skating community that equally respects our common interests and our differences for all skaters to enjoy the sport and fulfill their individual goals within a team spirit.

Guidelines for safe and fun skating sessions

- Always make sure you are looking out for other skaters, even when you are skating backwards. Pay attention at all times.
- You can practice your spins in the middle oval of the rink. You can practice your jumps in the corners of the rink.



- <u>Individuals skating to program/dance music have the right of way in ALL cases</u>. *Listen and recognize music and look to see who is skating*. This means that other skaters and coaches (even those in a private lesson) should leave space for those doing their program/dance to their music. Skaters should ask their coaches to identify solo/dance music so it can be recognized.
- If another skater is having a lesson with their coach, please make sure you get out of their way (unless you are doing your dance or your program to music).
- All skaters who accidentally run into each other or cut each other off are encouraged to say "I'm sorry" or excuse
 themselves in a polite manner, even if it appears that the other person is more at fault. It shows graciousness,
 maturity and respect qualities that bring out the best in all of us.
- If you fall, get up immediately.
- Please do not interrupt coaches when they are working with other skaters.
- Please show courtesy to all skaters and coaches. If you get in another skater's way, please be polite and apologize.
- Skaters can request to have their music played only ONCE outside of their lesson. If time permits, they can play their music once more in a lesson. Please make sure to sign up on the music sign-in sheet.
- Skaters are NOT permitted to use personal electronic devices while skating.
- Warm-ups are NOT permitted in the lobby space at INVISTA. The only place skaters can warm up is outside (lots of green space) or in our rink by the boards/in the changerooms. This includes practicing jumps, jump-rope, cardio, etc.
- All skaters must get off the ice as soon as the session ends, and <u>before</u> the Zamboni starts flooding.
